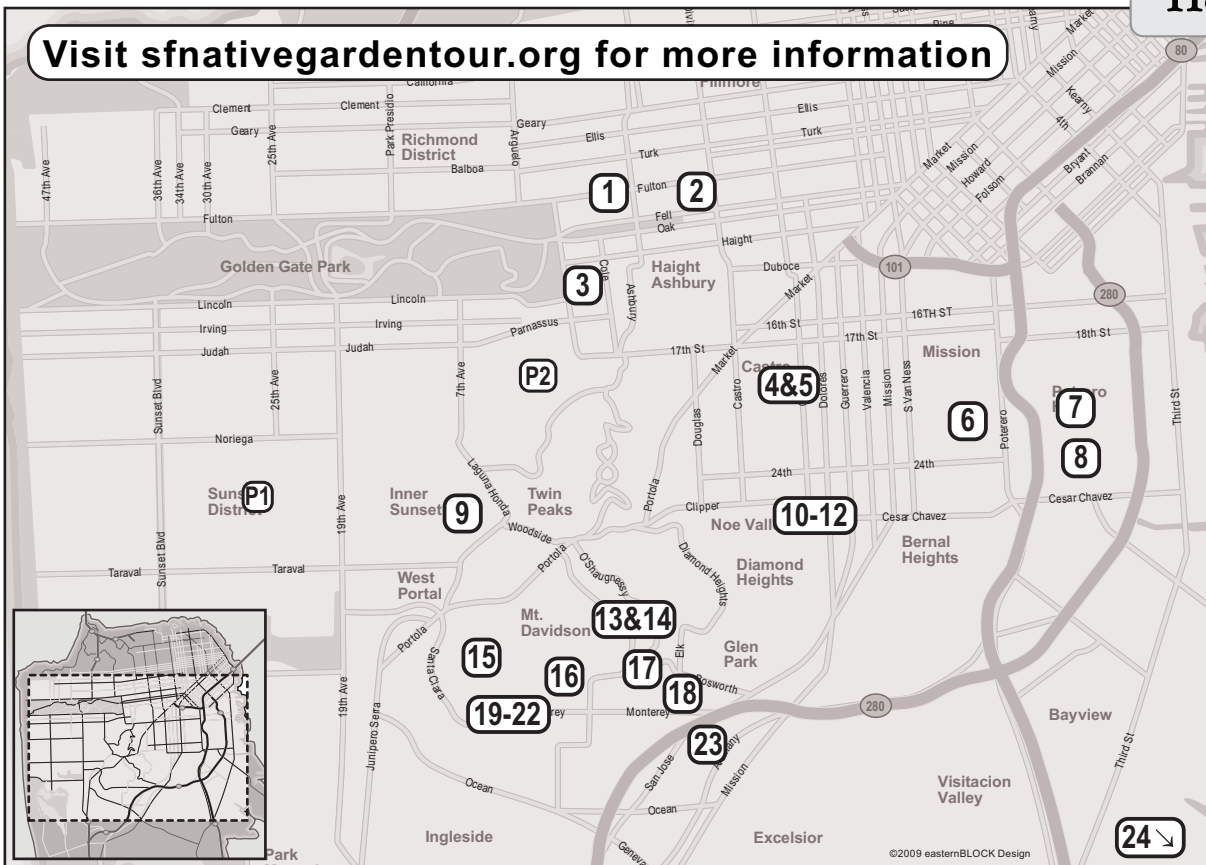

1. 1946 Grove Street Apt. 3

A previously neglected yard now features local natives from including Cleveland sage, Heucheras, Lewisia, and manzanita and seaside daisy.

2. 534 Broderick

A 6-year old native conversion of a shaded rear and sunny sidewalk gardens that incorporates grey water.

3. 156 Beulah Street (at Stanyan)

This garden features California natives such as ferns, spicebush, rushes and native bunchgrasses.

4. 261-263 Cumberland Street

This retired gardener's garden is planted for insects, butterflies and birds with established and recently-planted natives.

5. 3696 19th Street

A sidewalk garden with a focus on local native plants including sticky monkey flower, a collection of Sidalcea, Iris and Arctostaphylos.

6. 954 Florida Street

Sidewalk and back gardens feature a rich assortment of natives including the SF endemic franciscan manzanita.

7. 785 Carolina Street

A shaded garden rich with native plants and insects. Access is through the owner/artist's studio.

8. 86 Caire Terrace*

This established garden on a sunny slope is a small forest of native shrubs, trees, flowers, and groundcovers.

9. 206 Castenada Avenue

This newly-transformed native garden features shade-loving natives such as fern, ginger and redwood sorrel.

10. 3984 26th Street

This newly-transformed garden features shade-loving native fern, ginger and redwood sorrel.

11. 158 27th Street Apt 1

This front and backyard garden supports over 50 native species and features a converted parking area planted entirely with San Francisco natives.

12. 163 27th Street #2

This garden shows what happens when a formal garden of exotics is converted to native species.

13. 34 Valletta Court*

A large cliff garden filled with oaks, buckeye, coffee berry, and other shrubs, flowering plants and many grasses.

14. 4 Valletta Court

Added 3 years ago, the natives in this garden include red buckwheat, ceanothus, bee plant, Douglas iris and pink flowering currant.

15. 440 Hazelwood Avenue

Formerly a lawn, this garden has now grown into a feast for the eyes along a public stairway.

16. 630 Mangels Avenue*

A 2-year old native conversion on a steep and terraced slope including redwoods, ribes and a host of other springtime delights.

17. 11 Malta Drive*

A steep garden that exemplifies what can be done with natives even on difficult terrain.

18. 257 Joost Avenue*

Your challenge here is to find at least fifteen varieties of native plants woven into this sensuous, eclectic garden of flowers and shrubs.

19. 220 Hazelwood Avenue

Come and enjoy the many species in this 100% native garden recently converted from a lawn.

20. 85 Hazelwood Avenue

This front and back yard garden is a diverse collection of natives, succulents and geraniums

21. 25 Hazelwood Avenue

A former lawn, this small garden is now reaching maturity with many native shrubs and perennials.

22. 59 Hazelwood Avenue

A mixed garden showing the long term results of mixing natives with traditional exotics.

23. 642 Cayuga Avenue

This dry, sunny front yard showcases a durable cohort of natives grasses, bushes and flowers.

24. 809 Ada Street, San Mateo

A garden focused on pollinators and their hosts. Legacy roses mingle with a rich assortment of natives including manzanitas, ceanothus and iris
