

Long Blooming San Francisco Native Plants

Ground cover

Dune Tansy (*Tanacetum bipinnatum*) - yellow flowers (long bloom July-Oct)
Manzanita cultivars *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*, 'San Bruno Mountain', 'Point Reyes', 'Radiant', 'Wood's Red', 'Emerald Carpet', 'Green Supreme' (long bloom Jan-March)
Barberry (*Berberis aquifolium* var. *repens*) - yellow flowers (long bloom Jan-May)
Baccharis pilularis 'Twin Peaks No. 2', 'San Bruno Lady', 'Pigeon Point' - yellow flowers (long bloom Sept-Jan)
San Bruno Mountain Sessileflower Golden Aster (*Heterotheca sessiliflora* ssp. *bolanderi* 'San Bruno Mountain') yellow flowers (long bloom March-Dec)

Annuals

Goldfields (*Lasthenia californica*, *glabrata*, *glabrata* ssp. *glabrata*, *minor*) - yellow flowers (long bloom Feb-June)
Lupine (*Lupinus formosus*, *polyphyllus*, *variicolor*, *bicolor*, *nanus*, *microcarpus*) - purple and blue flowers (long bloom Apr-July)

Short flowers

Yarrow (*Achillea millefolium*) - white flowers (long bloom April-Aug)
Beach Primrose (*Camissoniopsis cheiranthifolia*, *cheiranthifolia* ssp. *cheiranthifolia*) - yellow flowers (long bloom Jan-Aug)
California Sand Aster (*Corethrogyne filaginifolia*) - pink flowers (long bloom June-Oct)
Seaside Daisy (*Erigeron glaucus*) - pink flowers (long bloom Jan-Aug)
Yellow Stonecrop (*Sedum spathulifolium*) - yellow flowers (long bloom April-July)
Sun Cup (*Taraxia ovata*) - yellow flowers (long bloom Feb-April)
Vervain/Verbena (*Verbena lasiostachys*) - purple flowers (long bloom Apr-Sept)
Mule Ears (*Wyethia angustifolia*, *helenioides*) - yellow flowers (long bloom March-July)

Shrub

Deerweed (*Acmispon glaber*) - yellow flowers (long bloom May-Aug)
Manzanita (*Arctostaphylos* species) - white or pink flowers depending on species (long bloom Jan-March)
Coyote Bush (*Baccharis pilularis*) - yellow flowers (long bloom Sept-Jan)
California Fuchsia (*Epilobium canum*) - red flowers (long bloom Aug-Oct)
Golden Yarrow (*Eriophyllum confertiflorum*, *staechadifolium*) - yellow flowers (long bloom Feb-Aug)
Goldentop (*Euthamia occidentalis*) - yellow flowers (long bloom Aug-Oct)
Gumweed (*Grindelia hirsutula* var. *maritima*, *camporum*, *hirsutula*, *stricta* var. *angustifolia*, *stricta* var. *platyphylla*) - yellow flowers (June-Sept)
Golden Aster (*Heterotheca sessiliflora* ssp. *bolanderi*, vine) yellow flowers (long bloom March-Dec)
Dune Goldenbush (*Isocoma menziesii*, *menziesii* var. *vernonioides*) - yellow flowers (long bloom April-Nov)
Lupine (*Lupinus albifrons*, *chamissonis*, *succulentus*) - purple and blue flowers (long bloom Apr-July)
California Buttercup (*Ranunculus californicus*) - yellow flowers - edible seed (long bloom Feb-May)

Pink Flowering Currant (*Ribes sanguineum* var. *glutinosum*, *malvaceum* and *divaricatum* var. *pubiflorum*) - pink flowers (long bloom Dec-March)
Hummingbird Sage (*Salvia spathacea*) - bright pink flowers (long bloom Feb-July)
Bee Plant (*Scrophularia californica*) - red flowers (long bloom Feb-May)
Goldenrod (*Solidago velutina* ssp. *californica* and *spathulata*) - yellow flowers (long bloom June-Oct)
Hedge Nettle (*Stachys ajugoides*, *bullata*, *chamissonis*) - purple flowers (long bloom Apr-Sept)

Hedge

Coast Barberry (*Berberis pinnata* *pinnata*) - yellow flowers (long bloom Jan-May)
Coffeeberry (*Frangula californica*) - white flowers (long bloom June-Aug)
Cream Bush (*Holodiscus discolor*) - white flowers (long bloom May-July)
Malva Rosa (*Malva assurgentiflora*) - pink flowers (long bloom Feb-July)

Vine

Western Morning Glory vine (*Calystegia purpurata*, *purpurata* ssp. *purpurata*, *soldanella*) - pink and white flowers (long bloom April-June)
Pacific Pea vine (*Lathyrus littoralis*, *vestitus* var. *vestitus*, *jepsonii*) - pink flowers (long bloom March-May)
Pink Honeysuckle vine (*Lonicera hispidula*) - pink flowers (long bloom April-July)

Tree

Toyon (*Heteromeles arbutifolia*) - white flowers (long bloom June-Aug)
Hollyleaf Cherry (*Prunus ilicifolia*) - white flowers (long bloom Feb-April)
